Prizes will be given to the winning group!

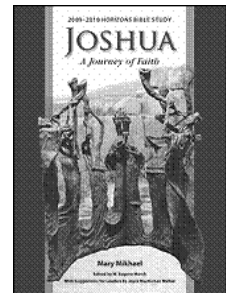
